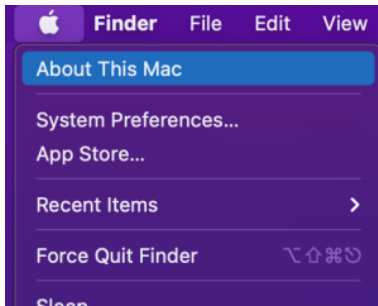


How to find System Information on macOS

This will show you how to find important System Information about your Mac such as the Model, Operating System, Memory, Serial Number and Network Information.

Step-by-step guide

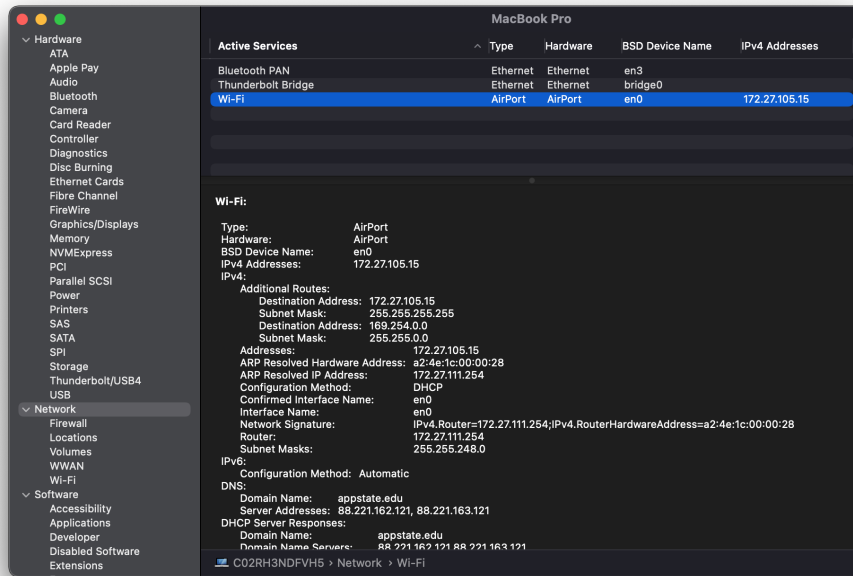
1. Click on the Apple logo on the top left corner of the Menu Bar, then click on About this Mac.



2. This will open up a window with some basic information. You can click on the tabs at the top to see more information about the respective topics.



3. To find comprehensive system information, click System Report. This will bring up a new window where you can find network information such as your IP Address and other useful information.
