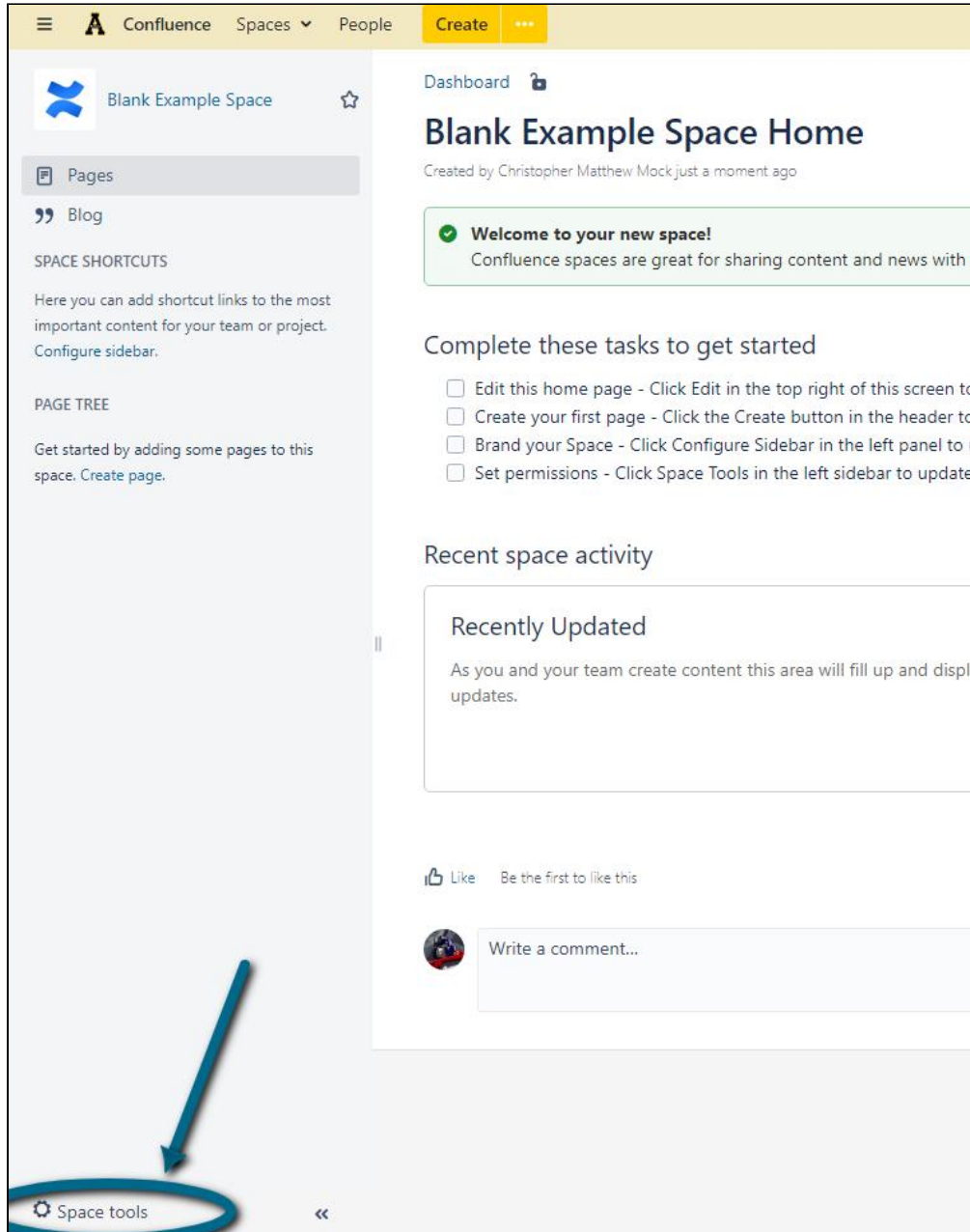


Edit Permissions on a Confluence Page

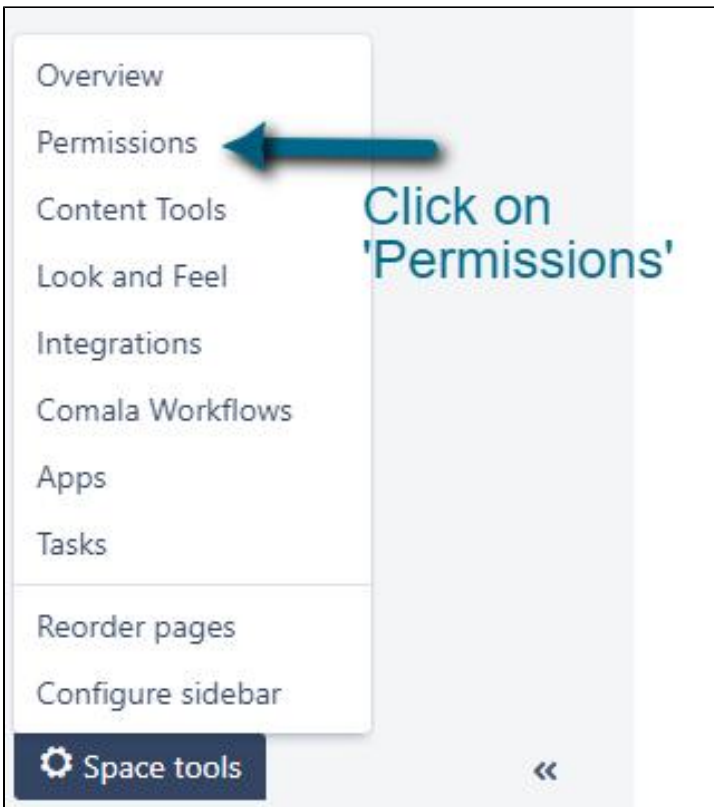

1. While in a Space click on the gear labeled 'Space tools' in the bottom of the Sidebar



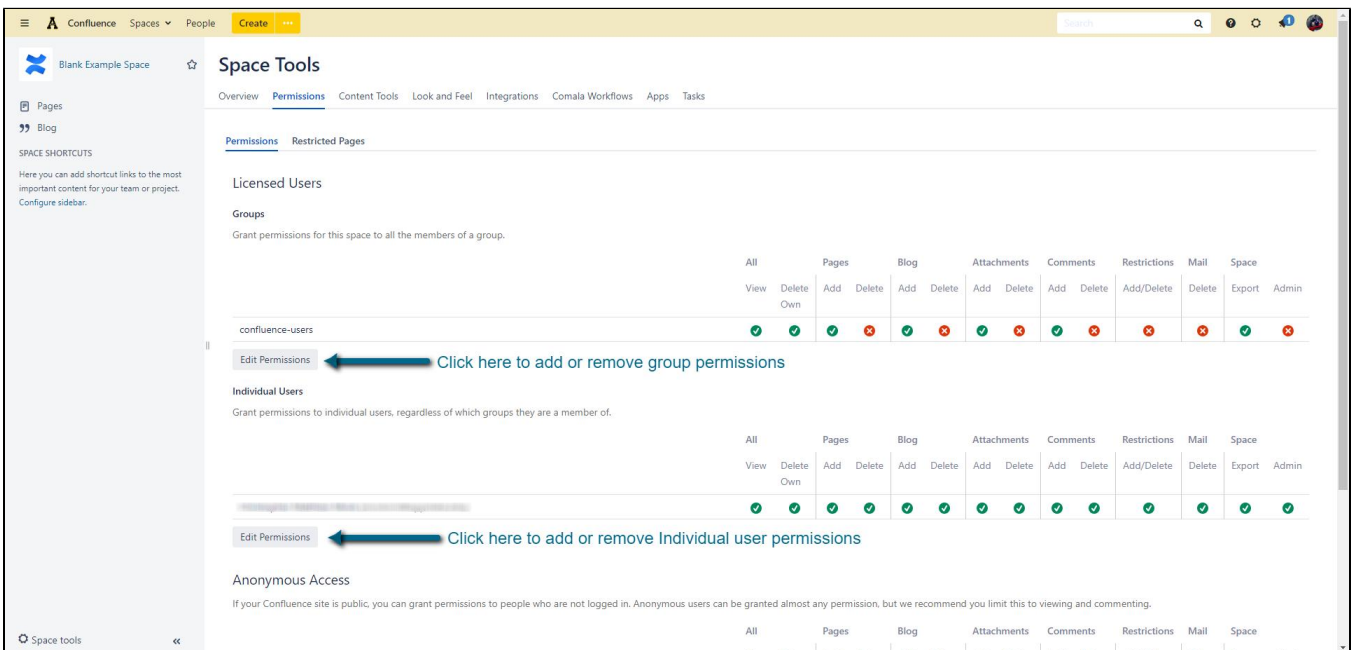
2. In the menu that appears click on 'Permissions'



3. This will open the permissions page for this space

- Permission can be added by groups as well as individual users

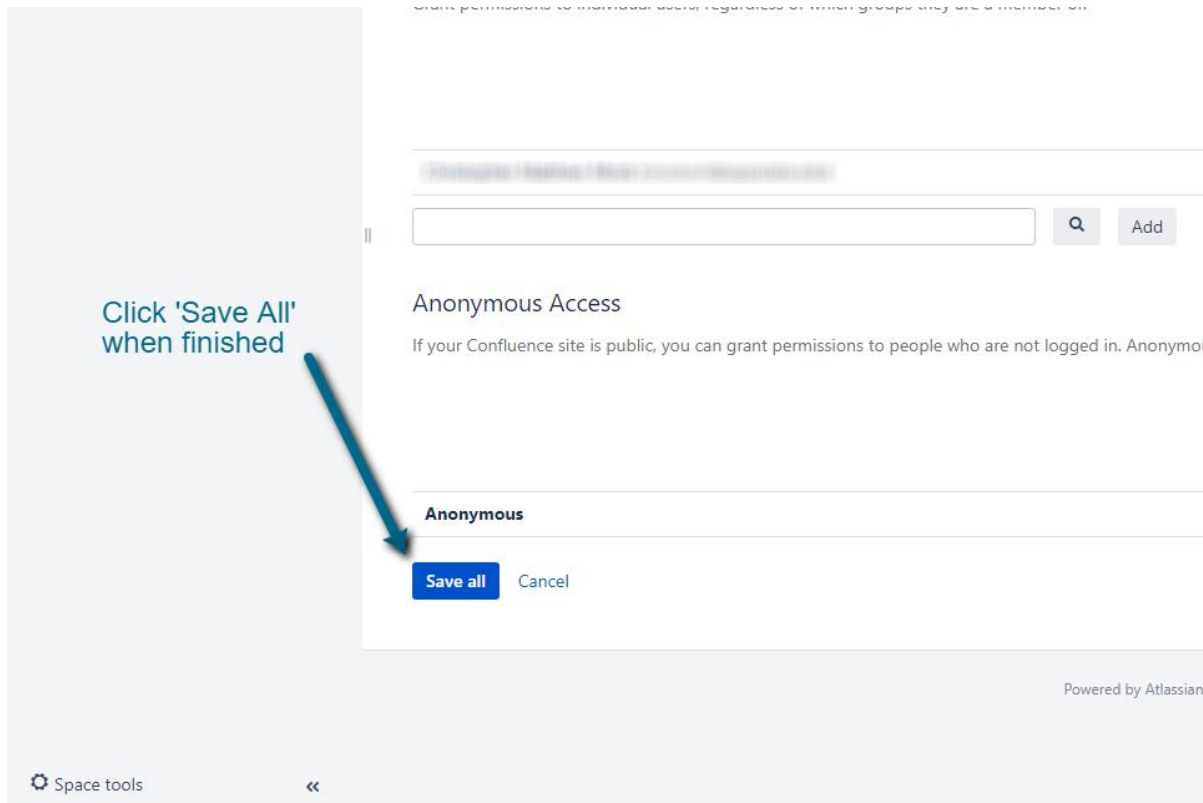
4. Click on 'Edit Permissions' under the type of permissions you need to add
