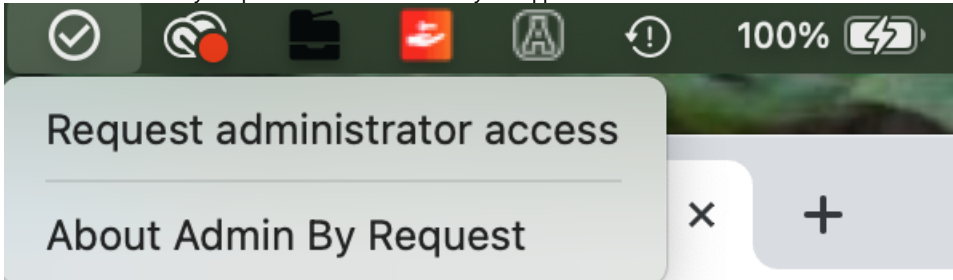


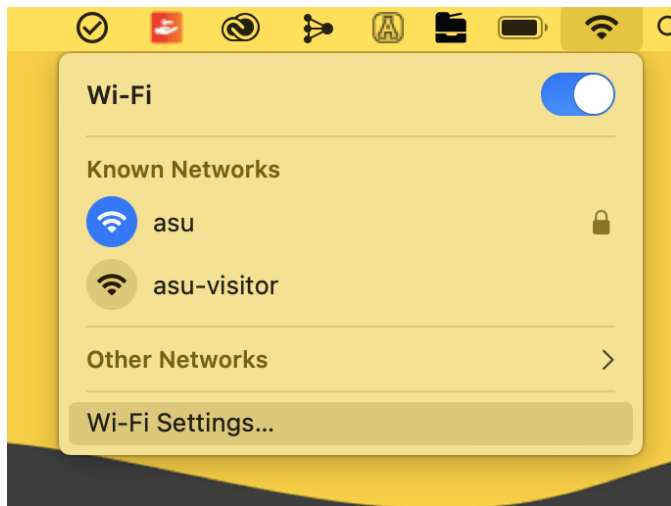
Fix ASU Wifi after Password Change on macOS

After you change your password using the Password Manager, your Mac will sometimes have trouble reconnecting to the ASU wireless network. This guide will walk you through how to fix the connection and setup ASU wireless again.

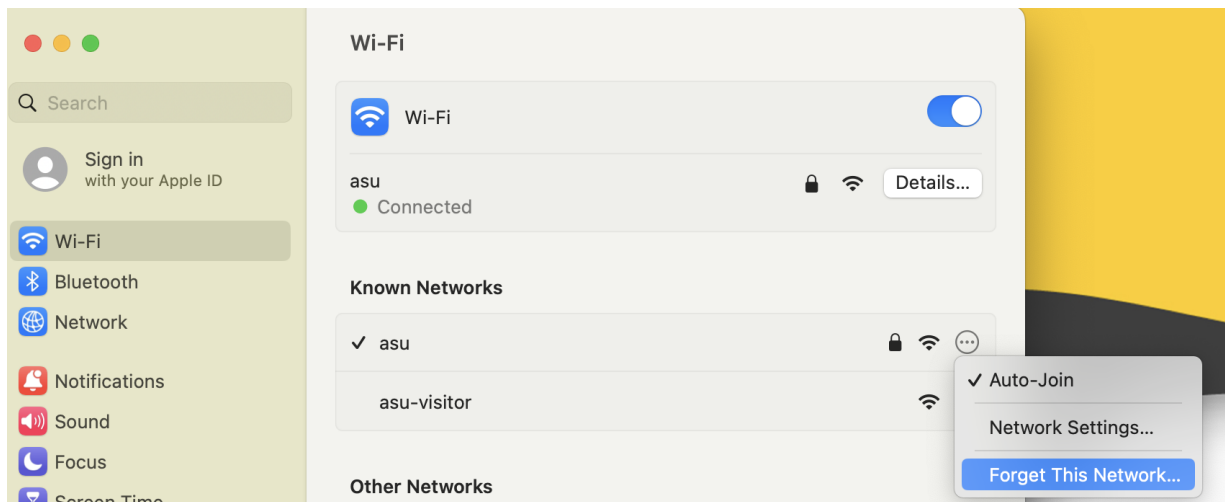
1. ****Run Admin By Request** from the **circled check-mark icon** in your menu bar and select the **Request administrator access** from the drop down menu. Admin By Request can also be found in your Applications folder.



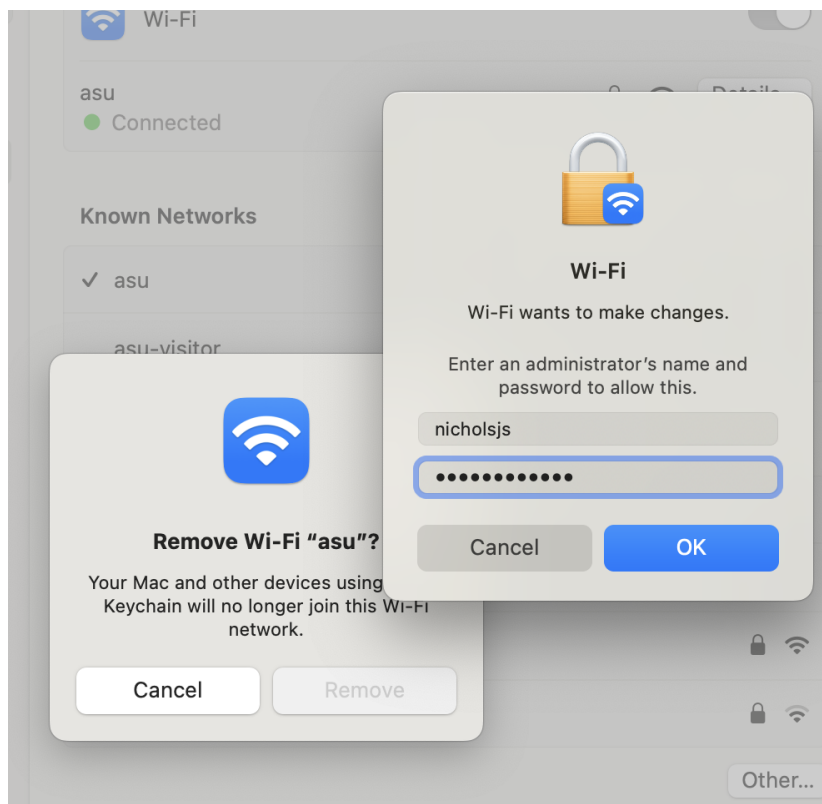
2. Click on the Wi-Fi icon in the top right menu bar and select **"Wi-Fi Settings..."**



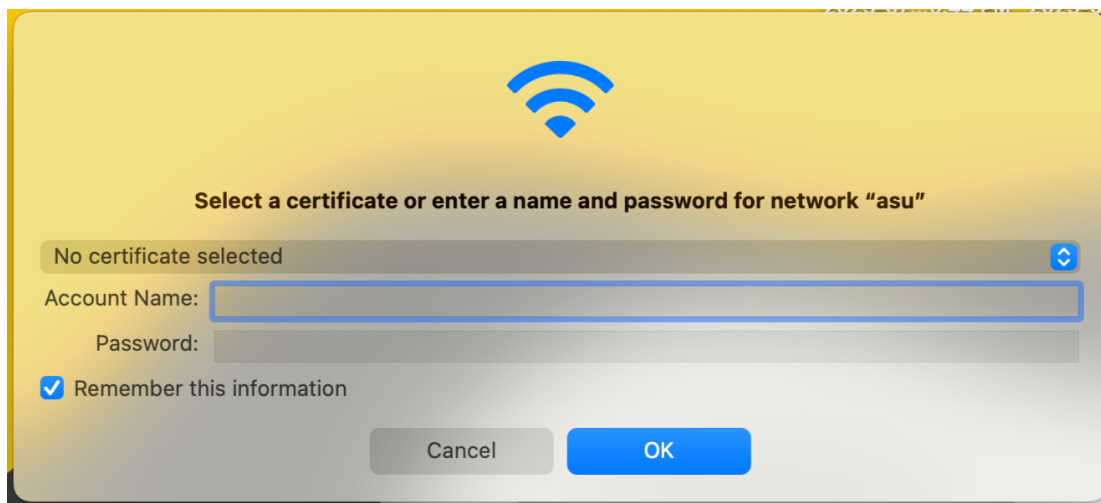
2. Under 'Known Networks,' click the three dots beside asu and then click **"Forget This Network..."**



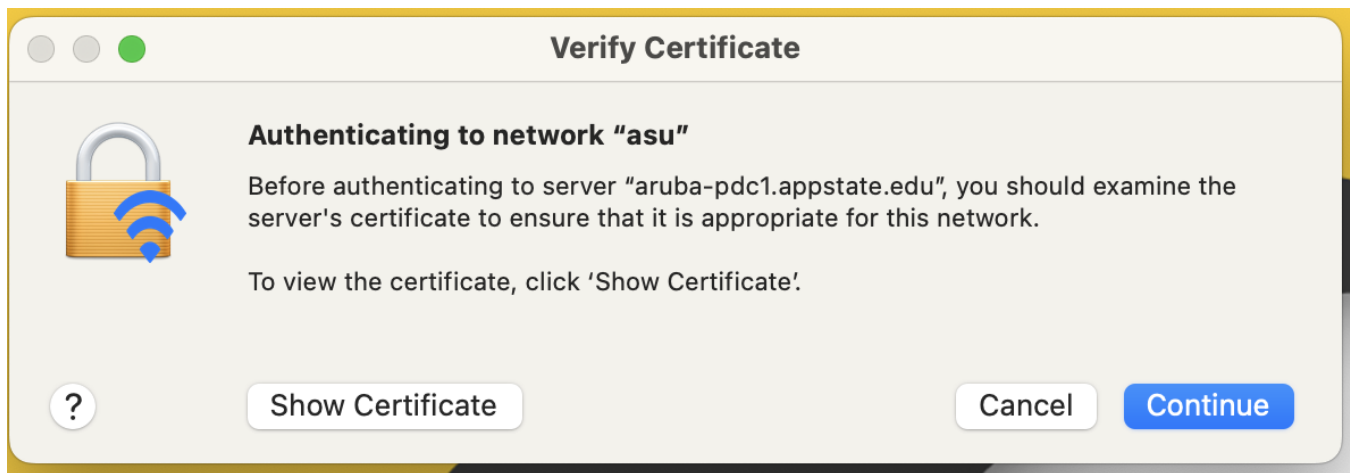
3. Enter your credentials and click OK to remove the network.



4. Return to the Wi-Fi icon in the top right of the menu bar and select '**Other Networks,**' and then select **asu**.
5. Enter your AppState credentials and click **OK**.



6. Click **Continue** to verify the certificate. You should now be successfully reconnected to the asu wireless network.



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
