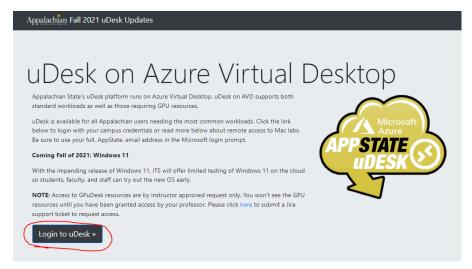

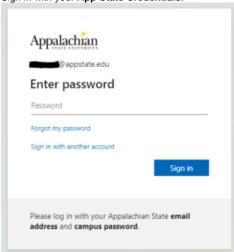
Step-by-step guide

On any Mac or PC, open a web browser such as Chrome, Firefox or Safari and go to: https://udesk.appstate.edu

1. Click on Login to uDesk.



2. Sign in with your App State Credentials.
