



How to Configure ASU Wireless on iOS Devices.

This guide describes how to configure your iOS Device (iPhone, iPad, etc.) on asu secure wireless:


1. Launch the **"Settings"** App from the home screen on your iOS Device.




2. Tap **"Wi-Fi"** on the left side of the **"Settings"** menu, then choose **"asu"** to connect to the App State secure network.



3. Enter your App State credentials and tap **"Join"**.




4. Tap "Trust" on the certificate pop-up.



5. If this is your first time connecting this device to the asu network, you will need to register. To do this, open a web browser and navigate to netreg.appstate.edu.

6. Login with your App State credentials and complete the registration.





- You must wait 15 minutes for registration to take effect and you may need to reboot your device.
- Students are allowed 4 device registrations and Faculty/Staff are allowed 5 registrations on the asu secure network.
