Reset Date & Time on Mac

Date and time can get out of sync on Mac computers, which causes issues with connecting to asu wifi and other systems and settings.

1. In the upper-right corner of your screen, click on the circle with the checkbox and select request administrator access.



- 2. From the Apple Menu in the upper left corner, Open System Settings > General > Date & Time
- 3. Turn OFF Set time and date automatically, then set the date and time manually.
- Once it's set, turn ON Set time and date automatically, using Apple (time.apple.com) as your source.
