

# Groups: Messaging

If enabled by the Teacher, the group messaging feature in AsULearn allows group members to communicate in a group chat using the messaging feature. The easiest way is to allow group messaging when you create the group, but you can edit the group and enable it as well. See the [Groups support page](#) for details on adding groups. Note that this messaging feature can be particularly useful when used with the [AsULearn Mobile App](#).

## Step-by-step guide for enabling Group Messaging in existing groups

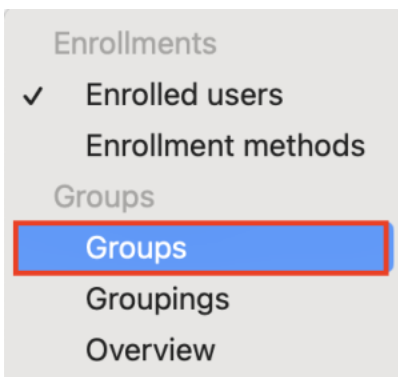
Follow these steps to enable group messaging

1. From the Course Menu on your course homepage, click **Participants**:

## 5. Save changes

Group messaging is **only** a feature for members of the group and the user will see the groups they belong to (with Group Messaging turned on) in the messaging drawer (word balloon icon at the top right). Teachers do NOT see the function to send a message to a group in a course unless they are a member of that group.
