Classroom



Overview

Classroom is a lightweight learning management system (similar to AsULearn) that provides native integration with other **Google Workspace** (formerly G Suite) products. After creating a class, users can add other **Gmail** account users, even if they're not affiliated with App State. Each class has a <u>Calendar</u> for scheduling and a <u>Drive</u> folder, which can be used to store, share, and collaborate on files, and allows for total control of assignment submission.

Access

On the web, access Classroom by navigating to https://classroom.google.com.

Note: If you are logged into a personal **Google** account in the same browser, you may be redirected to the inbox for that account. See this <u>Help Document</u> to add a second account to your browser session.

On a mobile device, access Classroom via Google's official Classroom app, which is available for free in the App Store (iOS devices) or Play Store (Android devices).
